Some Quick Updates:

We are officially out of strict Quarantine, but still have several restrictions

The government has allowed the possibility to reactivate church activities. We are developing procedures with professional council and legal documentation to reopen the ministry and church. We have bought all the biosecurity features, right now we are coordinating the visit of the person who is going to give us the professional council and legal documentation. The weekend of the 16th of October we plan to have 4 meetings for 2 hours on Saturdays and 2 meetings Sundays now that the occupational capacity is only 35%.

Stephanie has been sending biweekly audio Bible lessons to the women's group through WhatsApp since the women don't have access to internet or other means of communication. She has shared on being various topics: your relationship with your spouse, being a Proverbs 31 woman, prayer, parenting tips, your personal relationship with Christ, and the Gospel of John.
